- Parents/carers are encouraged to observe the EAL sessions.
- No smoking is allowed.
- Anyone under the influence or not adhering to the code of conduct will be asked to leave.
- Please give at least 24 hours' notice of cancelling a session where possible otherwise you may still be charged a late cancellation fee.
- All staff, volunteers, visitors and animals are to be treated with respect.
